

STUDENT CONDUCT ON BUSES – DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE

Safe bus transportation is a privilege that can be taken away anytime a student's conduct is considered to jeopardize the safety of the other passengers. Those students who are found guilty of disobedience or misconduct on school buses are subject to discipline as cited in the District's policies and guidelines listed below:

- The school Principal is the designated representative for the District authorized to suspend pupils from riding the bus when situations warrant.
- Suspensions will not begin until the next school day following the day notification of suspension is sent to the pupil's parent or legal guardian.
- If a pupil has been denied the right to ride a school bus for disciplinary reasons, the parent or guardian of that pupil has the right of appeal to the Assistant Superintendent within ten (10) days of suspension notification.
- Until the appeal is heard it will be the parent's or guardian's responsibility to provide transportation for the pupil to and from school for the suspension period.

Repeated violations may result in suspension from riding the bus for the remainder of the school year by Board action.
