PARENTAL OBJECTIONS TO SPECIFIC MATERIAL

In the event a parent/guardian finds specific course material objectionable, the parent/guardian will need to notify the building principal of the specific material to which they object and request that the student receive alternative course material, sufficient to enable the child to meet state requirements for education in the particular subject area. This notification and request shall be in writing.

The building principal and parent/guardian must mutually agree to the alternative course material. The alternative course materials agreed upon must meet state minimum standards.

Any cost associated with the alternative course materials shall be borne by the parent/guardian.

Nothing in this policy shall be construed as giving parents/guardians the right to appeal to the school board.

Parents/guardians who wish for particular course material be reviewed for appropriateness may submit a request for review in accordance with School Board Policy KEC.
