HOMEWORK

Homework is a necessary part of the learning process and a legitimate demand on student's nonclass time. The District's professional staff has the right to assign work outside the instructional day to supplement classroom instruction. Homework will:

- Be relevant, appropriate for age and ability of students, and reflected as a portion of the student's grade.
- Be meaningful and foster lesson enrichment, application, review and practice of skills previously taught and learned.
- Provide an opportunity for open-ended individual activities encompassing a variety of levels for suitable student response, activities, and outcomes.
