

CREDITS FROM LACONIA ACADEMY

The Laconia School Board endorses the availability of the Laconia Academy Program, also known as the Laconia Adult High School Diploma Program, for Laconia High School students. In doing so the Board recognizes that some students can and will benefit from taking courses through the Laconia Academy Program.

Board Policy is that Laconia Academy credits may be applied toward the ~~20 1/4 credit~~ requirements for a Laconia High School diploma based on the following:

- Laconia Academy Course options are available only with the prior approval of the Laconia High School Principal and meet the minimum age requirement of 16 years old or greater.
- Students wishing to take Laconia Academy courses must receive prior approval from their Guidance Counselor, High School Administration and the Director of Adult Education.
- Students enrolled in Laconia High School and Laconia Academy are by definition dually enrolled students.
- One high school credit will be granted for a one credit Laconia Academy course, provided a passing grade is earned.
- The High School Principal will determine how many credits will be accepted from the Laconia Academy Adult Education Diploma Program toward the fulfillment of credits needed to meet Laconia High School graduation requirements.
- The Laconia High School Principal may waive the Laconia Academy tuition cost of dually enrolled students.
