

ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO CLASSES AND GRADE LEVELS

The services of the district are extended to any qualified person of school age. All students enrolled in grades K through twelve are expected to attend school for the academic year according to the days scheduled on the school calendar and as established by state law.

The School Board believes that it is important that school officials and parents work together for the best interests of the children. The objective of proper class and grade placement of the students in the district is to implement each student's program at the point most conducive for productive learning. The decision with regard to class and grade level placement or retention will be made by the school principal after a thorough review with the parents the teachers and other school officials.

Placement decisions may be appealed first to the principal, then to the superintendent. The school's recommendation and parent's desired placement will be taken into consideration when placements are made.
