COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING

It is the policy of the Laconia School Board that District schools will attempt, when circumstances warrant, to provide special or extended services to students residing within any of the other member towns and attending local schools. The Board has developed procedures and regulations for this activity outlined in LBB-P, COOPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMMING PROCEDURES and LBB-R, COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING REGULATIONS. The Laconia Board has agreed, through mutual arrangements with the Gilford School Board to provide the following special opportunities and services:

- To make available to Gilford students, at no tuition charge, pupil placements at Laconia High School in courses not offered at Gilford High School, subject to the following conditions:
 - The final recommendation must come from the professional staff.
 - The proposed placement must be substantially more beneficial to the student than his or her present placement.
 - The administrations of the participating schools must agree to the placement.
 - The placement may be terminated by either school on thirty (30) days notice.
 - The School Board must approve each proposed placement.
 - Transportation is the student's/parent's responsibility and not the District.
- Share teachers with the Gilford School District when neither District can offer a full and advantageous professional assignment.
 - Shared teachers will be subject to the negotiated agreement, and paid according to the salary schedule of, the District of his or her majority assignment.
- Final approval of teacher sharing and exchange pupil placement is the responsibility of the Superintendent.
